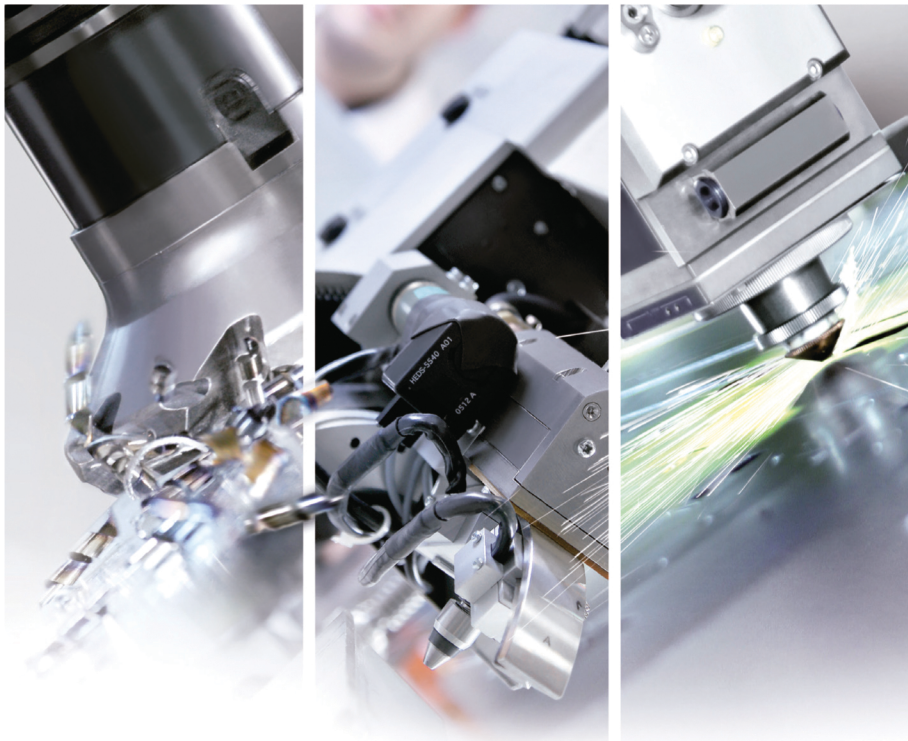

POs are evaluated and improved inviting them to the second stage.

The Full Project Proposal (FPP)

is a complete description of the project objectives, excellence, implementation work packages and expected impact.

Successful FPPs will be labelled as SMART Projects.

With the SMART label, project participants can apply for funding in their respective countries

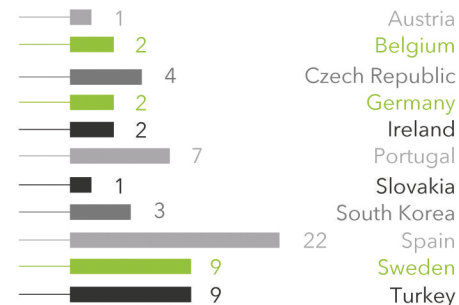

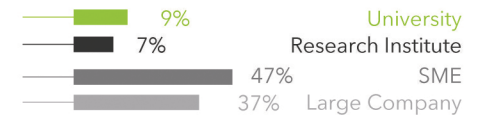
Project partners from interested countries are invited to contact the project officers of their National Funding Agencies during the earliest phase of their project definition in order to explore potential funding options.
